Look for milk that has been certified organic or carries the words 'no artificial hormones.' Conventional dairies inject cows with synthetic recombinant bovine growth hormone (rBGH), aka bovine somatotropin (rbST), to boost production. The practice has been implicated in udder infections, requiring more veterinary antibiotic use, and is banned in many countries. Some scientists worry the hormones may affect consumers.

53 per cent turnout in Chhattisgarh in first phase: officials

An estimated 53 per cent of the 63.9 lakh voters today exercised their right to franchise in 39 Assembly seats of Naxal-hit Chhattisgarh where polling was held in the first phase, election officials said.

Heavy snowfall and thunderstorms hit Kashmir Valley marking early onset of

winter as normal life was paralyzed and all flights, including those scheduled to carry Haj pilgrims, cancelled on Friday.

A six-inch-thick blanket of snow covered Srinagar and other parts of the Valley as the first snowfall of the season, which is usually experienced in December

Yuvraj pulverises England to set up India rout

Yuvraj Singh struck the second fastest one-day century by an Indian to set up a crushing 158-run victory over England in the first one-day international on Friday.

The 26-year-old left-hander smashed 138 not out off just 78 balls to help India post an imposing 387 for five for their best one-day total against a test-playing nation.

Paes-Dlouhy lose again, bow out of Masters Cup

Leander Paes and Lukas Dlouhy ended their Masters Cup campaign without winning a single set, bowing out after

a third (rpt third) successive straight-set defeat here today.

The third seeded Indo-Czech pair lost their last round robin match of the Gold group 1-6 4-6 to the second seeded pair of Canadian Daniel Nestor and Serbian Nenad Zimonjic. **Federer falls to Murray, Simon in semis**
Simon defeated Radek Stepanek 6-1, 6-4 and Federer lost to Andy Murray 4-6, 7-6(3), 7-5 on Friday in Shanghai. That leaves Simon at 2-1, Federer at 1-2, and Stepanek 0-2 behind red group leader Murray. So Simon is in and Federer is out. No ties. No tiebreakers necessary.

Metallica is an American heavy metal band that formed in 1981 in Los Angeles. Founded when drummer Lars Ulrich posted an advertisement in a Los Angeles newspaper, Metallica's line-up has primarily consisted of Ulrich, rhythm guitarist and vocalist James Hetfield.

The band earned a growing fan base in the underground music community and critical acclaim, with the 1986 release Master of Puppets described as one of the most influential and "heavy" thrash metal albums.

The band has won seven Grammy Awards, and has had five consecutive albums debut at number one on the Billboard 200, making Metallica the only band ever to do so. The band released their latest album Death Magnetic on 10th Sep 2008. On October 21, 2008, Metallica started their World Magnetic Tour.
